# All About Me Book Project

**Explanation of Project:** Students will be creating a picture/photo journal to share with their classmates. Students will use/take pictures, use magazine pictures, or draw (color) pictures to organize their book. Students will need to neatly write sentences to explain the pictures and finally give an oral presentation of their book.

**Directions:** Students will place pictures of important people, things and events in their daily life. Students must include pictures of the following: self-portrait, family members, any pets, favorite activities and or hobbies. You may also want to include: pictures of where you live, favorite things (stuffed animals, toys, treasures, collections, books, and foods), other special people, or activities, and important places. Students will need to have 10-15 pages in their All About Me book project.

Students will put at least one picture per page. They will then neatly write at least 1 describing sentences to go with each picture. These sentences should include what the picture is and why it is important to the student. They may also include other interesting information if they like. Students will make choices as to how they organize their pictures and descriptions. Students will also need to design cover art and include an author page with their full name, date, and self-portrait.

**Presentation:** Students will need to bring their book in on Friday, August 30th. Students will share and orally present their books to the class. They will have 3-5 minutes each to share their projects.
