September Homework: Careers

These can be printed photos or cut outs from a magazine or newspaper. Your child will then give a 3-5 minute presentation on the career of their choice. The project will be due Monday, September 28th.

Requirements:

- Must have a creative poster board
- What do you do in the career you chose?
- What education or schooling do you need to hold a job in this career?
- Why did you choose this career?
- Who is someone who works in this career? Ex: Author-Dr.Seuss.
- Minimum of 3 pictures
